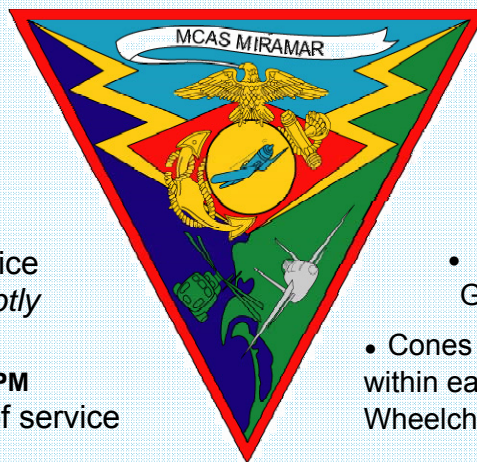

SUPPORT HADASSAH and Our Partnership with Israel's Defense Forces (IDF)

The United States and the world learns from Hadassah's expertise and experience in treating battle casualties, handling mass trauma, and from its emergency preparedness programs.

- The **School of Military Medicine at Hadassah**, in conjunction with the Hebrew University, trains the physicians for the Israeli Defense Forces. Students learn to treat battle-field injuries and serious trauma, including treating chemical, biological, and nuclear attack injuries.
- The Israel Defense Forces regularly **transport critically ill patients** to Hadassah Medical Organization for emergency treatment and care.
- In December 2011, **Researchers at Hadassah Hospital** concluded that Cognitive Therapy may be the best way to treat Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder.
- As part of **Hadassah's Lone Soldier Program**, the *Merkaz Hamagshamim* Center provides a 'home away from home' for soldiers on weekend and holiday leave who have no family to go home to. This program is funded by Hadassah's Youth Aliyah Project.
