The National Board of Hadassah, the Women's Zionist Organization of America, expresses its profound sense of concern and compassion for the plight of the Kampuchean people who have been forced to flee their native land.

As Jews we cannot help but have special understanding of their perilous circumstances and call upon the people of all countries to support efforts to assuage the suffering and hunger of these people.

Furthermore, we commend the generosity of the people of Israel who have voluntarily organized aid for Kampuchea and sent medical teams, which include Hadassah physicians.
