Hadassah, the Women's Zionist Organization of America, urges the implementation of national programs to explore and develop alternative domestic energy resources, lessening our dependence on imported fuel.

Despite current adequate fuel supplies, we must not become complacent and, therefore, we urge a strong program of energy conservation and education encouraging a deeper understanding of our nation's long-range energy problems.

We view the establishment of a substantial strategic oil reserve among the highest national priorities in reducing U.S. dependence on foreign oil, thus assuring the independence of U.S. foreign policy.

We call on all Americans to continue personal programs of energy conservation.
