CHILD CARE

Hadassah, the Women's Zionist Organization of America, in light of the teachings of our people, considers adequate and available child care programs necessary and of prime importance to the welfare of families and to the well being of American society.

Hadassah supports measures which will improve federal, state and private standards for monitoring, licensing and reviewing day care facilities, along with provisions for sufficient training of qualified child care workers. In furtherance of its belief in the need for comprehensive child care, Hadassah urges the adoption of measures which will require adequate funding by the public and private sectors.
