What was daily life like for a Navy officer's wife in California during World War II? In China amid civil war? In London and Continental Europe during the Cold War? *She Also Served: Letters from a Navy Wife* offers an up-close and personal account of one woman's life during extraordinary times. With an eye for detail and an irrepressible sense of humor (Shanghai is about as primitive as New York! It is like pioneering in the Palace Hotel!), Virgilia Short Witzel (1910-2004) tells the lesser-known stories of the Greatest Generation, those of a woman who served behind the scenes.

Her younger daughter, Christine Witzel, sifted through hundreds of Virgilia's private letters, finding the most entertaining and historically interesting selections. Born in California after the family returned from China, Christine attended Castilleja and Stanford, then earned a Ph.D. in Sociology from the University of Connecticut. She spent 25 years in high tech and has lived in Palo Alto since 1983.

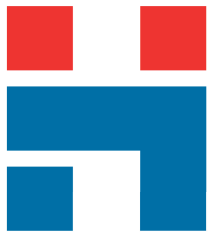
