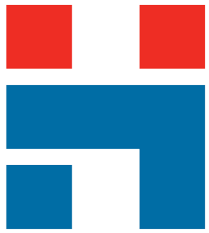

Passings: Yetta Heynick, Age 97

A few days following Yetta's 97th birthday, and a special Hadassah Birthday Party in her honor, Yetta died of natural causes. After retiring from teaching math in the Palo Alto Unified School District in 1984, Yetta devoted her time and energy to Hadassah, where she held many offices and received many awards. Yetta was a member of Sequoia's Circle of Founders and an active Board member right up until the time of her death. For many years, she was almost single handily responsible for creating and producing our annual Calendar Book. With the income from it, the Chapter was able to make a large annual donation to her favored Hadassah Medical Organization (more than \$12,000-\$15,000 annually). **Yetta will be sorely missed.**

Due to an exceptionally large number of donations to Hadassah for her birthday and in her memory, we are unable to list everyone's name here. Her daughter Carla wishes to add that she was overwhelmed and touched by the outpouring of cards she received.
