Jeff Pulver defined "VON" to stand for Voice/Video on the Net. From 1997 to 2008 he hosted and produced the VON Conferences which directly contributed to the worldwide acceptance of VOIP. Using his work, in 2004 the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) issued what is known as "The Pulver Order". In 2009 Jeff started hosting a conference series looking at the effects of social media on business and life known as the "140 Characters conference," #140conf. Since 1995, Jeff Pulver has been involved in many startups as a founder, co-founder, advisor, and/or investor. Some of his startups include Free World Dialup (FWD), the VON Coalition, Vivox, and VOIP Provider Vonage. Jeff recently started a new conference series, Pulver HWC which explores how we communicate.
