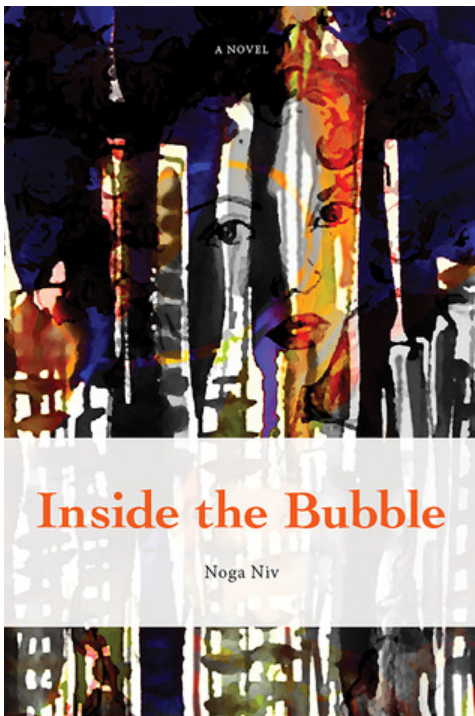




CALLING ALL READERS, WRITERS & BOOK FIENDS
