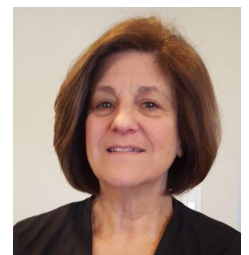

She has taught fundraising courses throughout the U.S. on relationship based fundraising and solicitor training and is the recipient of numerous professional fundraising awards of recognition. Jaime received her MSW from the University of CT and her B.A. from Boston University. She is a life member of Hadassah and her mother previously served as President of the Hartford Chapter of Hadassah.
