PRESIDENT'S COLUMN

Some people think the days are getting shorter and shorter as we go through December. In fact every day is the same 24 hours long – it's just that the hours of daylight are getting fewer and the hours of darkness are increasing. That situation will begin reversing itself after the winter solstice on December 22. And before then, we will welcome the Festival of Lights. It's easy to imagine how the Jews of 2,000 years ago wished to remember going from the darkness into light, from Roman domination into the light of liberty brought about by the Maccabees' victory. When it feels as though we are still suffering the darkness of terrorists with knives, we hear stories of patients at Hadassah's Hospitals bringing their victims back into the light. Here is one of those stories, told to us by Barbara Sofer when she visited us from Israel last month for our Chai Society dinner.

"Naor, 13, was putting air in his bicycle tire when he was stabbed and critically injured by Palestinian Ahmad, also 13. As he tried to run away the Palestinian boy was hit by a car, severely wounded, and was transported to Hadassah Hospital Ein Kerem. Naor was evacuated to the ICU at Hadassah Mount Scopus in critical condition. After seven days on a respirator, Naor was awake and breathing on his own. A complicated surgery was performed to save Naor's life. His recovery is attributed to Prof. Ahmed Eid, head of the department of general surgery, his staff, and particularly Dr. Inna Akopnick, a vascular surgeon. Naor has been discharged from Hadassah-Mt. Scopus. Since Naor's identity was kept out of the media, the press was unsure if the boy was alive or dead. Hadassah confirmed that he was alive and in good hands. Ironically, Ahmad, his attempted murderer, was claimed to be dead by PA Prime Minister Abbas. He is alive, was hospitalized at Hadassah and eventually released into police custody."

I look forward to seeing you at our upcoming Chapter Installation on January 10 when Sandra Smith our new president and our 2016 board will be installed. These women will lead us forward to meet and exceed our goals to add new members and raise the funds needed for our Hadassah work to continue. I take this opportunity to thank our outgoing chapter board for their priceless service this past year. Not priceless because we don't pay them, but priceless because they are invaluable!

What is a Matching Gift?

A matching gift is when an employer, corporation or foundation matches the charitable contribution of its employees and/or their spouses and, in many cases, its retired employees and /or their spouses.

How can a Matching Gift benefit YOU and Hadassah?

It is a win-win for the member and Hadassah because the member reaches a donor level commensurate with the gift plus the match. For example: A donor who has a \$500 gift matched by her company can become a Keeper of the Gate which is an annual minimum commitment of \$1,000. .
