PRESIDENT'S COLUMN

For some, a New Year starts with a champagne toast. For the Houston Chapter it starts with a new Board to be installed Sunday, January 8. All our group installations will take place in January as well. Back in 1912, Hadassah started with two nurses. This month I'm going to tell you about two modern day Hadassah nurses. But, first, Houston Chapter's upcoming events.

It's official! Houston Hadassah is moving to 24 Braeswood Square in February and we are very excited! Getting confirmation that our lease had been accepted capped off a year full of accomplishments. We are planning several new and exciting events in 2017. On March 26 we will sponsor **Know Your Worth: Own Your Future, Financial Education for Women in Transition**. Designed with our members in mind, **KYW** will explore how to ensure long-term economic security, including managing income streams; honing your financial and negotiating skills; investing and growing your money; all in the context of the Jewish values that underlie these decisions. On May 9 we will be hosting a **Chai Society** event featuring speaker Teddy Weinberger, a columnist for the *Jewish Herald Voice*. And we will have a two-part event, **BREAST STROKES, Hadassah Bares All for A.R.T. (Awareness, Research & Treatment)**. In June we will host **Paint Day** followed by the **Big Reveal – An ART Gala and Auction in October**. Want to help paint or set up or to one of our models? Nurse Practitioner Caryn Scheinberg Andrews immigrated to Israel six years ago from Baltimore. As a lecturer in the Hadassah-Hebrew University Henrietta Szold School of Nursing, Dr. Andrews (PhD, RN, CRNP) has taken up the cause of creating a cadre of advanced practice nurses. Israel has been slow to adopt this most useful strategy. With a growing physician shortage, professional nurse practitioners will have a significant role to play in health care delivery, especially in underserved areas of Israel. Dr. Andrews's research shows better outcomes and a more cost-effective bottom line. NPs "reduce unnecessary emergency room visits, 30-day readmission rates, and waiting time for healthcare visits." **Keepers of the Gate** can direct their yearly contribution towards Nursing.

The second nurse you should know about is Dr. Polina Stepensky. She immigrated to Israel from the former Soviet Union and fulfilled her life's dream of becoming a physician, funding her medical education by working as a nurse. When Dr. Stepensky arrived in Israel with three years of medical school training in the Ukraine, she realized that the competition for medical school entrance in Israel was too stiff for her. With no English and limited Hebrew, she was advised to enroll in nursing school. By the time she graduated as a registered nurse, she had upgraded her
