Hadassah's origins are deeply embedded in the nursing profession. The organization's first project was to send two American-trained nurses to Jerusalem in 1913. Hadassah Nurses' Councils were formed to establish an international partnership with the Hadassah Medical Organization nurses in Israel.

The mission: to enhance and support the nursing profession in the United States and Israel by meeting the special educational, social and professional concerns of Jewish/Zionist nurses in both countries. Currently, there are approximately 3,400 nurses who are members of the 35 Nurses' Councils in the United States.
