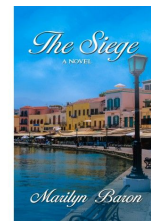
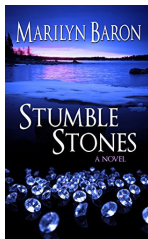


**Hadassah Greater Atlanta Metulla Group invites you to meet:**

Guest speaker Marilyn Baron lives in Atlanta and wrote both novels.

"Stumble Stones" is set in Berlin and is about a TV writer who gets a second chance at love when she flees to Italy and meets a lonely Berlin hedge fund bank manager who still believes in destiny. After a chance encounter on a flight to Rome, the unlikely pair face danger when they team up to return to their rightful owner a stash of WW II vintage jewels, while being pursued by neo-nazis.

Ms. Baron's latest novel is "The Siege", which is set on the island of Crete during World War II. In the novel, Artist Theia Constas receives a tour of Italy from her grandmother as a college graduation present. Before she departs, her ya-ya's deathbed revelation of a cache of WWII photographs and love letters extends Theia's itinerary to Crete in search of her unknown grandfather, a promising artist who studied under Chagall but didn't survive the war.
