***Hadassah General Policy**

Kashrut _The rules of Kashrut MUST be observed at all Hadassah functions

a. No non-kosher foods of any type may be served. Prohibited foods include- shellfish, pork and non-kosher meat products including chicken.

***b.** We consider that a fish, dairy or pareve meal at a hotel, restaurant or home is evidence of Intent to Comply with Kashrut procedure

c, Meats and dairy products may not be served at the same meal.
