On February 2nd the JCFR's Jewish Community Relations Committee will host the annual Jewish Advocacy Day/Date with the State where community members meet Commonwealth delegates, senators and senior members of the executive branch to advocate for our communal agenda. The JCRC welcomes community member participation.

The day starts at 8:30 AM at St. Paul's Episcopal Church, 815 E. Grace Street, Richmond. The program, co-sponsored with Richmond Hadassah, will begin with an executive briefing about our issues and this year's legislative agenda. Following that, participants will meet Commonwealth Senators and Delegates and have an opportunity to engage on important issues. After lunch, we have invited **Governor Terry R. McAuliffe**, **Lt. Governor Ralph S. Northam**, and **Attorney General Mark Herring** to speak. In addition, cabinet members are expected to participate.

The registration fee is \$30 and payment must be received no later than Friday, January 29th (see link above). This fee covers coffee at the morning session and lunch. Dietary laws will be observed, vegetarian option available.

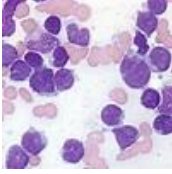
