Avinoam Lourie, was head of the Haifa Zoo, and then the Hai Bar Carmel of Israel's Nature Reserves Authority -- instrumental in bringing back endangered animal species to Israel, including (which was written up in the Wall St. Journal) the rare Mesopotamian Fallow Deer smuggled out of Iran just before the revolution; building a zoo in the West Bank town of Kalkilya (Animals know no borders); and so much more.

Avinoam also has the most interesting, entertaining stories about his own life with animals -- a bear in his bed; a jackal in his oven; monkeys in the living room -- plus a lot of volunteer work using animals to help abused, at-risk children; prisoner rehabilitation, etc. **(BTW, he is 7th generation Sabra; the first baby born at Hadassah Hospital at Mt. Scopus!)**
