Dr. Moran Bercovici is the founder of the Multidisciplinary Microfluidic Technologies Laboratory in the Faculty of Mechanical Engineering at the Technion-Israel Institute of Technology. His lab develops technologies and devices that would accelerate disease detection and enable rapid, sensitive, and low-cost diagnostics at the point of need. His field of "LabonaChip" may revolutionize biochemical analysis and processing in a similar way that computer chips revolutionized data processing.
